Rents Forum

 $\overline{3.2 \text{ Just } 12 \text{ ten}}$ ants attended the rents forum on 30^{th} November.

3.3 If the same budget was used then HRA would need to borrow $\pounds 435,000$.

3.4There was a discussion on proposed savings:-

Proposal

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•	Not replacing wet floor showers for new tenants	£100,000
٠	Increase rents for garage sites and pitches	£60,000
٠	Cyclical maintenance extended to every 7 years	£200,000

Savings

•	Removal of LEAP budget	£100,000
•	Money to be paid up front by tenants for personal damage	£20,000

3.5 The Repairs Service is to be reviewed.

3.6 There is to be a review of the Out of Hours Services – one change proposed is to change the definition of the emergency criteria.

3.7 Tenants arrears payments are also to be reviewed.

3.8 The proposal is for a rent increase of 1.8% which is below inflation for September 2013 and is based on the cost of the service budget. A decision will be made by Stirling Council in February 2014.

<u>4. AOCB</u>

4.1 Stirling council is proposing to use Priority Based Budgeting [PBB] and in order to do this Head of Service Officers have proposed savings by their departments.
